On March 16, 2002, Michael Roberts voluntarily submitted himself for a polygraph examination to investigate the veracity of his statements concerning an incident that took place in his home on December 13, 2001.

Before the test the subject signed a form releasing Michael Roberts of any liability which may result from the polygraph examination. The executed form release is incorporated as part of our laboratory file in this case.

During the course of the subject's polygraph pre-test interview, the subject stated in essence that the Sac County Iowa Sheriff's Department is investigating him as a possible suspect in the attempted murder of his wife on the evening of December 13, 2001. It is alleged that Mr. Roberts may have had something to do with a deceased home invader to his residence by the name of Dustin Wedhe. Police are exploring the possible connection between the subject and Mr. Wedhe, and possibly an unknown second offender who allegedly fled the subject's residence during the time in which Mr. Wedhe was shot and killed by Mrs. Roberts. The subject denies that he has had anything to do in trying to get someone to kill his wife. He states that he has no knowledge of who the unknown second offender was who was said to have been in the home at the time of incident nor did he have anything to do with these men breaking into his home.

There were no significant emotional disturbances in this subject's polygraph records on the irrelevant, the control questions nor the following relevant questions:

1. Did you help or plan with anyone to try and kill your wife on December 13, 2001?
ANSWER: NO
2. Did you plan with Dustin Wedhe to kill your wife, Tracey?
ANSWER: NO

3. Did you hire anyone to try and kill your wife?
ANSWER: NO
4. Did you help or plan with anyone to break into your home on December 13, 2001?
ANSWER: NO
5. Do you really know for sure who the second person was who broke into your home (on December 13, 2001)?
ANSWER: NO

Due to the absence of any significant emotional disturbances in this subject's polygraph records, it is the opinion of the Examiner that the subject is unresponsive to this technique and no conclusion as to guilt or innocence can be made in this case at this time. It is recommended, if deemed necessary, that the subject be given a polygraph examination at a later date to further clarify the results of his test.

It should be noted that the subject gave this Examiner rather extensive background information prior to the administration of his polygraph examination, which may account for the unemotional nature of his polygraph records at this time.
